DIPLOMA IN TEACHING ENGLISH TO SPEAKERS OF OTHER LANGUAGE

WHEN

Every year we organise one **FACE TO FACE** part-time course from **OCTOBER** to **MAY** in preparation for **MODULES ONE** and **MODULE TWO**.

The course runs most **WEDNESDAYS**:

1. **28 INPUT SESSIONS** in the morning (**9:30 AM TO 1:30 PM**)
2. Approximately **6 AFTERNOON SESSION** for teaching practice (**2:30 PM TO 5:00 PM**)

WHO

This course is open to native and non-native speakers. The course is run in English and so non-native speakers need to be at minimum **C1 LEVEL** in all four skills for English.

All candidates must:

1. be **21 YEARS OR OLDER**
2. have a **UNIVERSITY DEGREE** (or equivalent)
3. have a pre-service EFL certificate (Cambridge **CELTA** or equivalent)
4. have a minimum of **TWO YEARS FULL TIME** EFL teaching experience
5. undergo the selection process (pre-interview task and face to face interview).

COST

The total course fees are **€ 2.000,00** for the standard course. A non-refundable deposit of **€ 200,00** should be paid upon acceptance to secure your place on the course. The balance is due no later than **TWO WEEKS** before the start of the course. Course fees **DO NOT INCLUDE** Cambridge English Assessment entry fees for Module One e Module Two

If you require accommodation during a full time course please state this when you apply. This is usually in a private family home with access to cooking facilities and would cost around **€ 500,00** for the 4 weeks.

HOW CAN I ENROL?

To participate in any course you will need to complete the enrolment forms and the pre interview task. Return them to us including a passport sized photograph and your CV. The deadline for returning your forms is **TWO WEEKS** before the start of the course you wish to participate in.

Once your application form and pre-interview task have been received, you will be required to attend an interview with one of the course tutors. A "face to face" interview is preferable if possible. However, it can be done over the phone (skype if possible) at your expense (taking about 30 minutes). When we receive your application forms, we will contact you to arrange your interview.
