CERTIFICATE IN TEACHING ENGLISH TO SPEAKERS OF OTHER LANGUAGES

WHEN

Every year we organise 3 standard face to face courses:

1. **JANUARY TO MAY:** a part-time course involves lessons every **FRIDAY**, usually held from 10:00 till 18:30
2. **JUNE/JULY:** an intensive course, Monday to Friday (10:00 till 18:30, with a break for lunch), plus evening preparation
3. **SEPTEMBER:** an intensive course, Monday to Friday (10:00 till 18:30, with a break for lunch), plus evening preparation

COURSE FEES

The total course fees are **€ 1.700,00** for the standard course. A non-refundable deposit of **€ 200,00** must be paid upon acceptance to secure your place on the course. The balance is due no later than **TWO WEEKS** before the start of the course.

If you require accommodation during a full time course please state this when you apply. This is usually in a private family home with access to cooking facilities and would cost around € 500,00 for the 4 weeks.

ELIGIBILITY

This course is open to native and non-native speakers. The course is run in English & so non-native speakers need to be at minimum **C1 LEVEL** in all four skills for English.

All candidates must be **21 YEARS OR OLDER** and have a level of education that would allow them to enter a higher education institute (preferably have a **UNIVERSITY DEGREE**). They must also undergo the selection process (see below). No previous teaching experience is necessary (although useful).

HOW CAN I ENROL?

To participate in any course you will need to complete the enrolment forms and the pre interview task*, and return them to us including a passport sized photograph and your CV. The deadline for returning your forms is **TWO WEEKS** before the start of the course you wish to participate in.

Once your application form and pre-interview task have been received, you will be required to attend an interview with one of the course tutors. A "face to face" interview is preferable if possible. However, a video conference can be arranged using Zoom or Skype. When we receive your application forms, we will contact you to arrange your interview.
