ELIGIBILITY

This course is open to native and non-native speakers. The course is run in English and so non-native speakers need to be at minimum **C1 LEVEL** in all four skills for English.

All candidates must

- 1. be **21 YEARS OR OLDER**
- 2. have a **University Degree** (or equivalent)
- 3. have a pre-service EFL certificate (Cambridge CELTA or equivalent)
- 4. have a minimum of **Two Years Full Time** EFL teaching experience
- 5. undergo the selection process (pre-interview task and face to face interview)

How can I enrol?

To participate in any course you will need to complete the enrolment forms and the pre interview task*, and return them to us including a passport sized photograph and your CV. The deadline for returning your forms is **Two Weeks** before the start of the course you wish to participate in.
